

Nova Scotia Institute of Agrologists Reinstatement Policy

This policy is meant to provide direction for persons who have previously been a member of the Nova Scotia Institute of Agrologists but are currently removed from the registry and wish to have their status with The Nova Scotia Institute of Agrologists reinstated.

Reinstatement Potential Scenarios – Only the most applicable to each situation is to be followed

1. If a former P.Ag. /A.Ag. has been absent from the profession for greater than five (5) years and wishes to reinstate, the individual must:
 - a. Apply as a new member and pay the \$50 application fee;
 - b. If approved by the Membership Committee and Council, the individual must pay the current year's registration fee, and
 - c. Attend the "Professionalism and Ethics" information session.
 - i. If the individual left as an A.Ag. they will also be required to restart their A.Ag. training program.

2. If a former P.Ag. /A.Ag. is absent from the profession for less than one (1) year and wishes to reinstate to their prior designation and original program, the individual must:
 - a. Submit the application form along with the \$50 application fee plus a current full year's registration fee, and
 - b. Attend the "Professionalism and Ethics" information session.
 - i. If the individual left as an A.Ag. they will be required to resume their A.Ag. training program.

3. If item 2 does not apply and if a former P.Ag. /A.Ag. left the profession but was practicing agrology any time during the past one to five (1-5) years since leaving the profession, the individual must:
 - a. Apply as a new member and pay the \$50 application fee,
 - b. If approved by the Membership Committee and Council, the individual must pay the current full year's registration fee plus one additional year's full registration fee
 - c. Attend the "Professionalism and Ethics" information session.
 - i. If the individual left as an A.Ag. they will be required to restart their A.Ag. training program.

4. If a former P.Ag. /A.Ag. was not practicing agrology anytime during the past one to five (1-5) years since leaving the profession in good standing the individual must:
 - a. Apply as a new member and pay the \$50 application fee,
 - b. If approved by the Membership Committee and Council, the individual must pay the current full year's registration fee, and
 - c. Attend the "Professionalism and Ethics" information session.
 - i. If the individual left as an A.Ag. they will be required to restart their A.Ag. training program.

*The Membership Committee and/or Council has the ability to assign additional Professional Development hours to be completed within twelve (12) months of reinstatement.
